We have some exciting news to share with you – breathe has a new and improved look, which we hope you'll agree makes the system even easier to use.

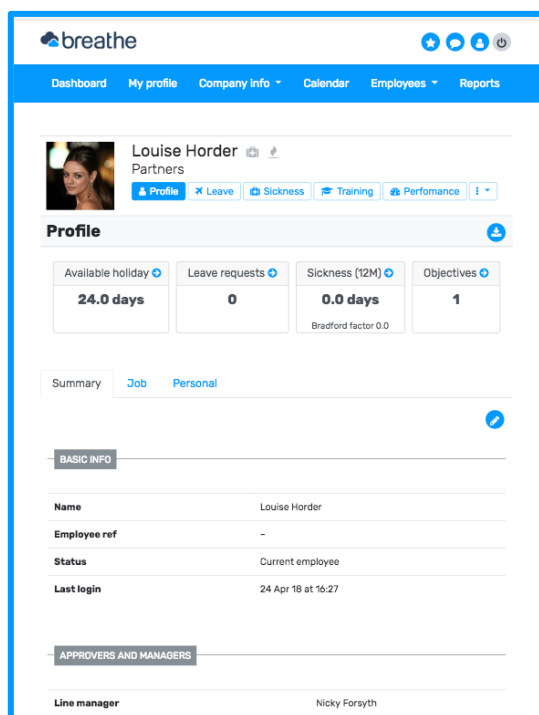
We wanted to reassure our customers that this is simply a UI (user interface) update and all **features and functionalities will remain the same**.

The purpose of the UI update is to:

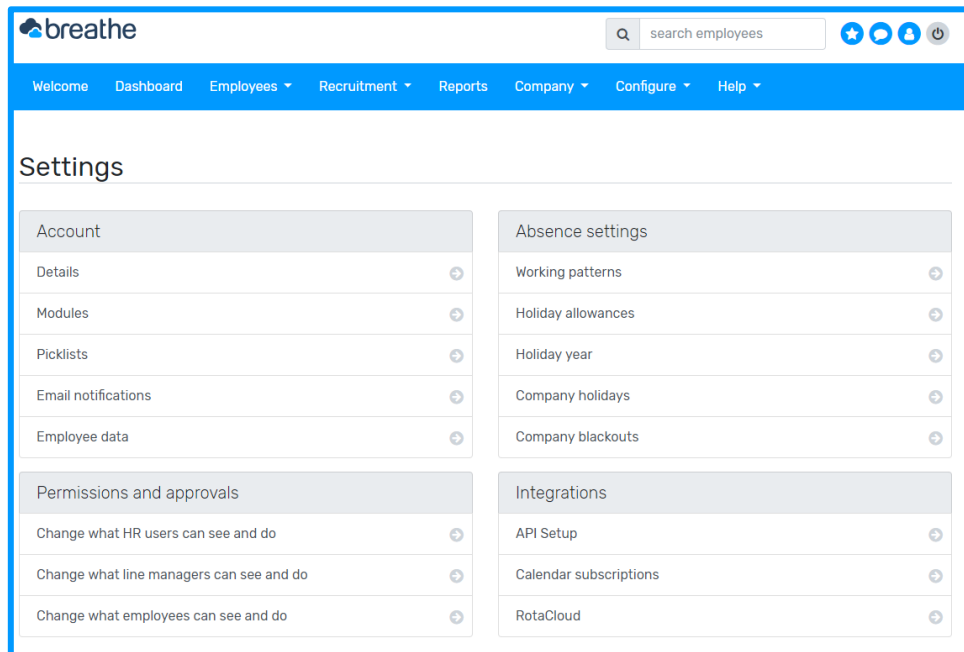
- make breathe even easier to use

Our beautiful new UI will launch on **24th July 2018!**

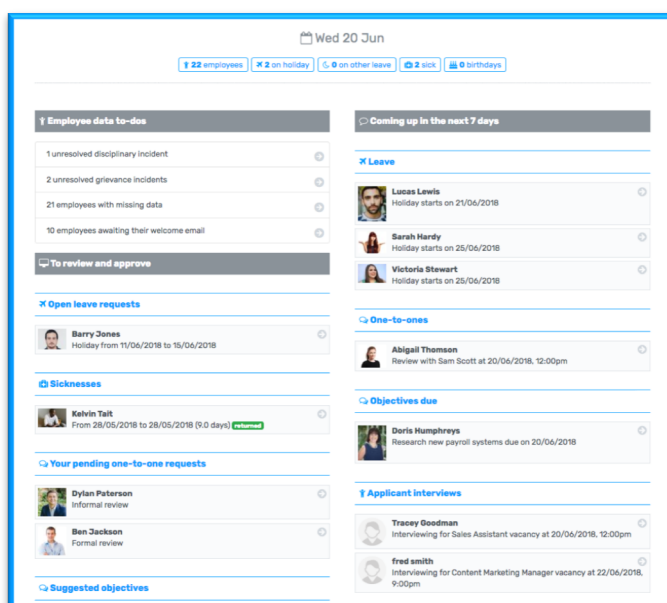
Here's a glimpse of what you can expect...



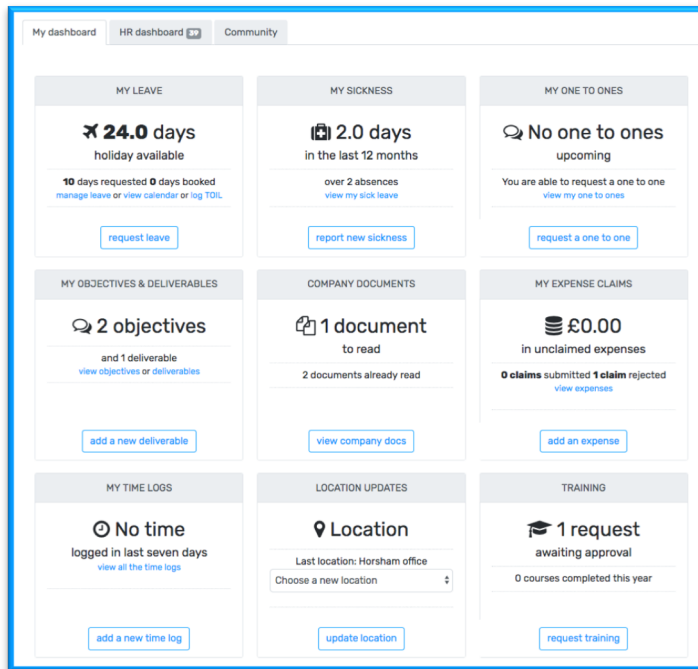

*This is your new **settings** page. You will find this under the configure drop down. This has been changed to make it easier to access your settings as everything is in one place and clearly labelled into sections.*

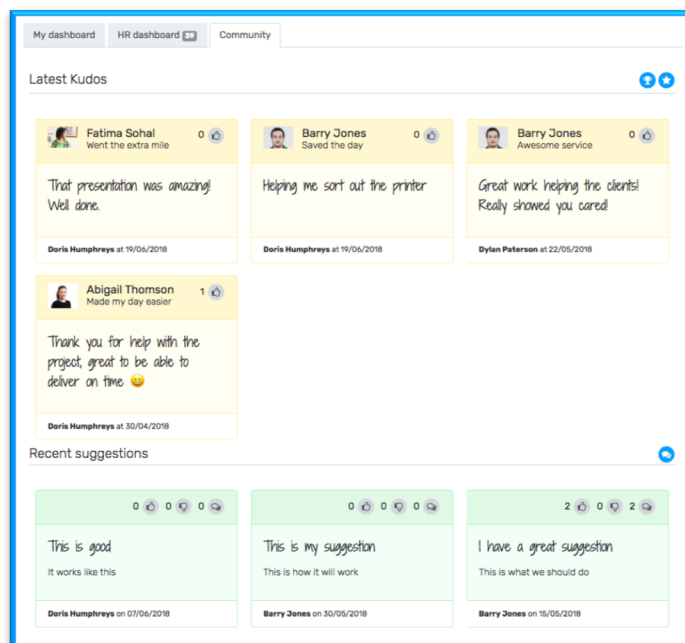


*This is your new **homepage** – the screen you see when you first login. This has been changed to give you a clearer overview of all the areas in your system.*

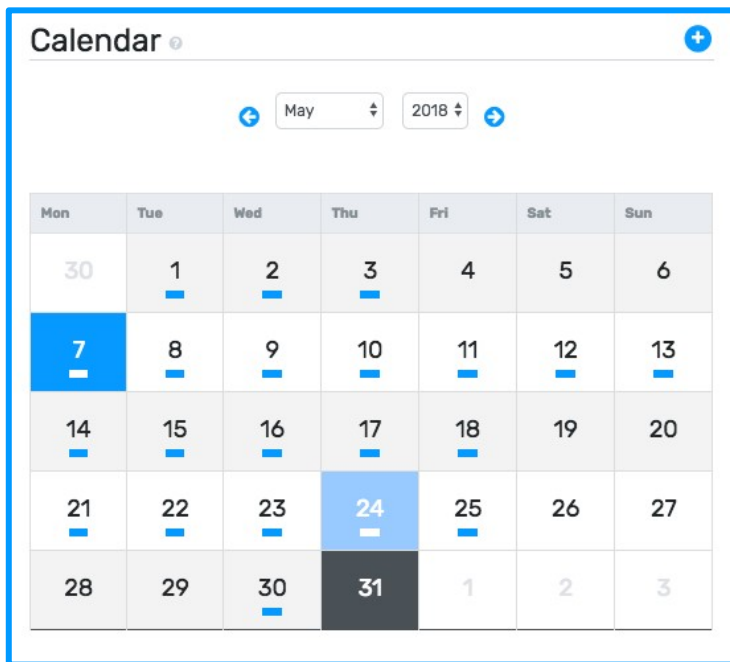


*This is your new employee **dashboard**. Here you can quickly and easily see how many days holiday you have remaining, any objectives or one to ones and any company documents left to read etc.*

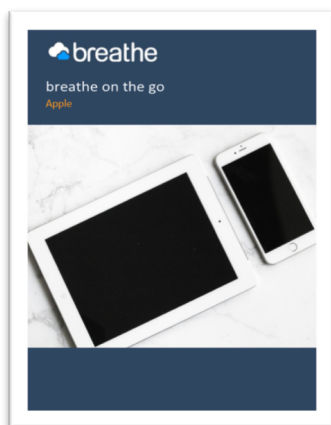
